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This poster describes a Bureau of Waterworks system that serves to efficiently aggregate damage information in the event of a large-scale disaster such as an earthquake or wide-ranging flood or power outage.

- Scrollable map
- Damage information collection and consolidation
(Facilities, pipes, etc.)
- Personnel information collection and consolidation
(Assembly status, etc.)
- Consolidation of emergency restoration and emergency water supply information
(Implementation status, materials and equipment stocks, etc.)
- Provision of customer support and assistance information
- Base personnel allocation and assignment
- Messane boards

At the Bureau, in addition to making pipes and other facilities more earthquake-resistant, we also work to build and utilize systems such as these so as to support Tokyo in minimizing water outages and securing drinking water for Tokyo residents as much as possible, even in the event of a large-scale earthquake.
